- Measures, marks dimensions and lay out material to be installed using tools such as lasers, rulers, calculators, and squares transit lasers.
- Solder, braze with oxygen & acetylene, use glue and primer for CPVC/PVC, cast iron, poly pipe, pex pipe.
- Install hanger assemblies for piping using unistrut, nuts washers, and clevis hangers.
- Ensure that efficiency is maximized while fabricating and installing Plumbing systems.
- Use of hand/power tools.
- Install systems according to specifications and appropriate trade/building codes.
- Perform other related duties or special projects, as assigned.
